What a busy few weeks it has been at Fowler Road School with numerous commemorations and events taking place across the school. Remembrance Day Activities were carried out within the classroom on 11 November 2020 to commemorate the occasion. On the day, all staff and students stopped at 11am for one minute of silence to remember those who served during the First World War and those who have died in conflicts since. During week 5, NAIDOC week celebrations were also implemented in classrooms. The NAIDOC Week Theme for this year was – Always Was, Always Will Be. During the week we were able to celebrate Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and provide our students with the chance to acknowledge our history, culture and achievements. Whole school activities included the completion of an Aboriginal mural on our school building by two Aboriginal artists. Classroom activities included Indigenous craft and dot paintings, listening to Aboriginal musicians and watching a movie about Aboriginal history. As part of National Bullying Prevention Week (16th November – 20th November), we also engaged in Super Hero Wednesday. Students were encouraged to dress as their favourite Superhero outfit or symbol to raise awareness of the dangers and impact of bullying and encourage personal responsibility on how we interact with others. It was great to see students dressed as different Superheroes and hear the different discussions in classrooms around the ways in which we can create a safe, valued and respected Australia; free from bullying.
