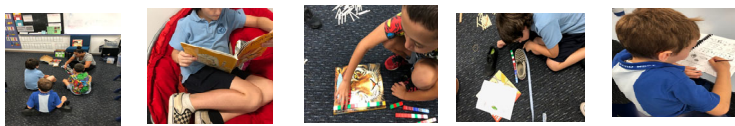
#### Just a reminder
